

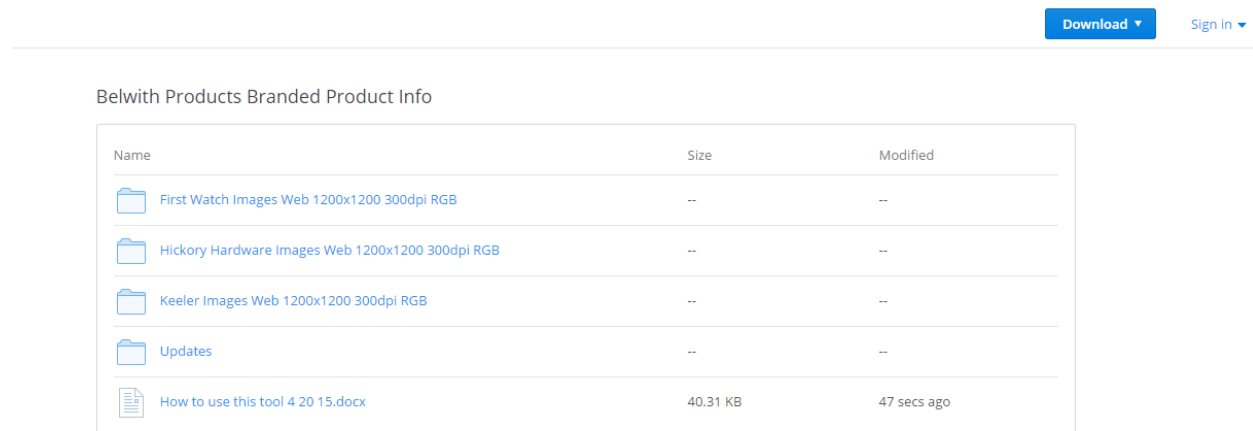
IMPORTANT NOTICE:

How to use this tool:

After you have clicked on the link given to you by your sales representative, you have a few options presented on the webpage. The first webpage will look like the screen shot below...



If you click on the download button in the top right you are presented with two options

1. Download as .zip – This will download all contents to a zip file onto your computer (total file size is about 1 gigabyte)
2. Save to my Dropbox – this will allow you to download all contents to your Dropbox folder should you have one

You may also click on individual folders to view its contents. See example below when clicking on the “Hickory Hardware Images Web 1200x1200 300dpi RGB”

****please note, unless you have a very fast connection it will take a while for the webpage to load****



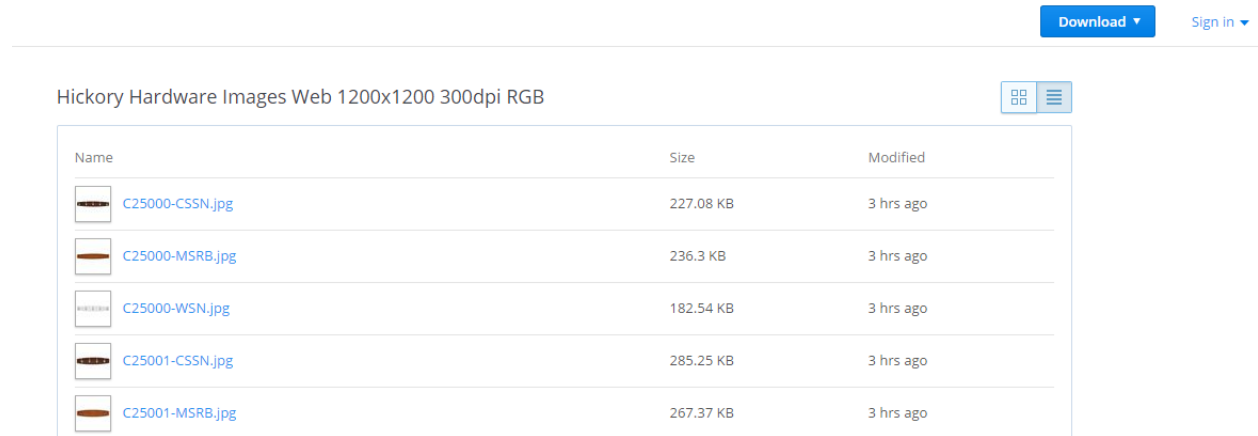
From here you can down the contents of the selected folder by using the download button in the top right.

To find a specific image:

Click on the four lined button below the word Download in the upper right of the webpage.



You will be presented with a new view that looks like this...



You can now use the find function on your computer to search for a specific item.

To download individual images:

Option 1

1. Click on the image you would like to download
 - a. The image will become full screen
2. Right click on the image
3. Click on the option "Download"

Option 2

1. Click on the image you would like to download
 - a. The image will become full screen
2. Click on 3 dots in the bottom right corner of the webpage – NOTE: if your mouse hovers over the three dots the text "More actions" will appear
3. Click on the option "Download"
